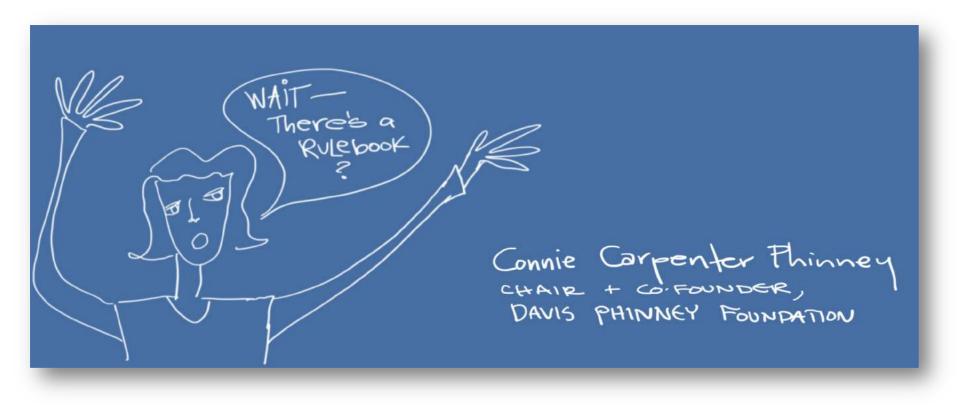

I believe in cultivating happiness.

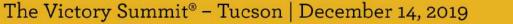
And keeping my halo untarnished.

It's okay to dislike Parkinson's. Avoid disliking your PWP.

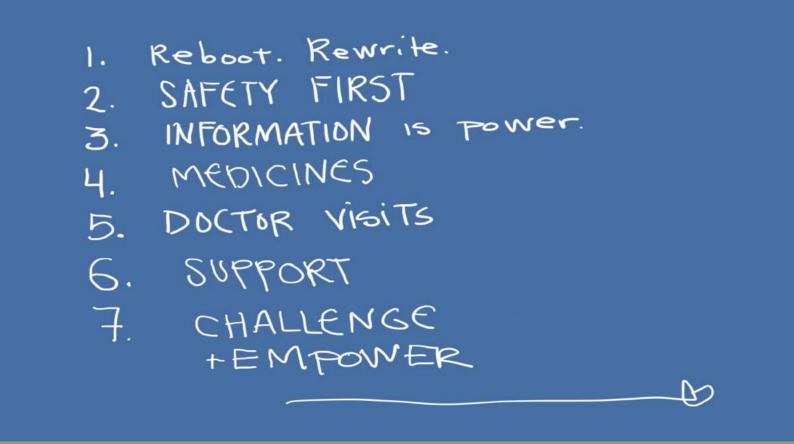
You can do this! Though you think – at times that you can't.

WHAT WE KNOW ABOUT FARKINSON'S

- It's 24/7
- It can turn your world upside down
- It involves daily concessions
- It's isolating
- It rarely plays nice
- It's unpredictable + complicated
- Tremor is the tip of the iceberg
- Non-motor symptoms are confusing + confounding
- We don't have a road map or GPS to guide us.















- The Rulebook must be dynamic, and will evolve over time.
- The Rulebook is a guideline for **optimal health, safety and well-being**
- The Rulebook is rooted in knowledge, relies on good manners and yet, demands respect.
- The Rulebook gives you the chance to reset*, assess, reorganize, and rebuild.
- The Rulebook will help you to avoid unproductive emotions like anger or guilt

2. SAFETY FIRST



every victory counts .

- Declutter (visually and physically)
- Remove tripping hazards (like area rugs)
- Minimize "fall" risks (like extension cords) No. Ladders. Ever.
- Maximize supports like grab bars
- Cane- for travel + early boarding
- Sleep safe

Nightstands? Separate beds?

• Driving? Get tested

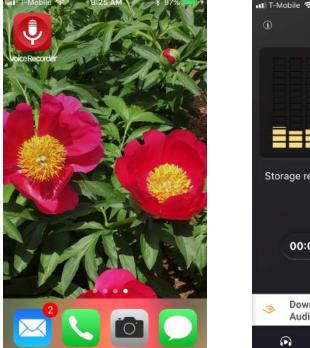

5. DOCTOR VISITS



every victory counts .

- NEVER let your PWP go to any doctor appointment alone.
- RECORD the conversation
- SEE a Movement Disorder Specialist at least once/year
- Get a signed HIPAA release from your PWP for each of your medical caregivers
- Get all of your PWP's legal docs in order
