#### Basic

- 1. Something to write with: pen or pencil (preferably with a sharp point)
- 2. Something to write on: paper (preferably plain)
- 3. Something to add color: a few colored pencils or watercolors such as the 8-pan set from Crayola
- 4. Printed "squares template" (at the end of this document)

OR

#### Good

- 1. A fine liner pen like a Micron in .01 or .05
- 2. Drawing/sketching or watercolor paper
- 3. Watercolors (8-pan set from Crayola is fine)
- 3. Printed "squares template" (at the end of this document)

OR

### **Better**

- 1. Two fine liner pens like a Micron in different sizes (i.e., 01 and .05)
- 2. Watercolor or sketch paper cut to size: four to six 2" squares, one to four 3" squares
- 3. Watercolor paper in size of choice (at least as big as your hand)
- 4. Watercolors (8-pan set from Crayola is fine)
- 5. Printed "squares template" (at the end of this document)

## **AND**, if using watercolor paints or pencils:

- 1. Wax paper or such to protect your working surface
- 2. A paint brush or water brush
- 3. Container of fresh water
- 4. Some paper towels
- 5. Eraser
